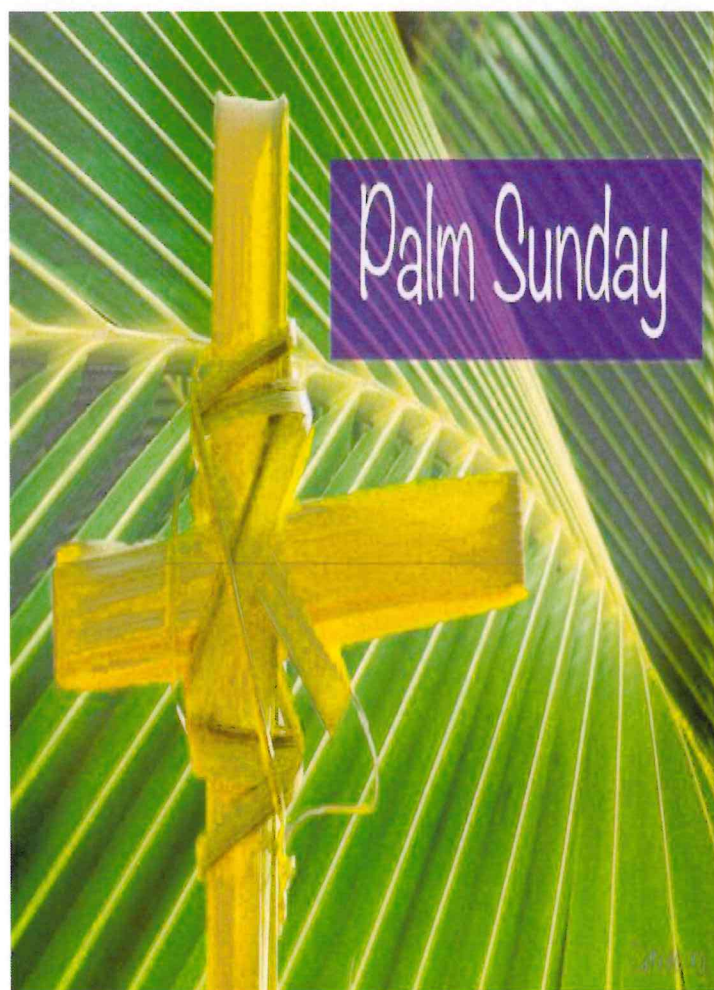

Reflection

Reflection for the 5th Sunday of Lent, March 17 and Palm Sunday, March 24, 2024

At first glance, the Gospel from John for this weekend, seemed to have no story line. That is, I thought the verses seemed disconnected from each other. What did Greeks who wanted to see Jesus, have to do with Philip and Andrew telling Jesus this, have to do with Jesus' response about the grain of wheat?

Sometimes, it is good to look back and see just where we have come from, in order to see where it is we are going. This is true of the Gospel reading this week from John. I read through the beginning of chapter 12 to find out what happened before Philip and Andrew gave Jesus the message from the Greeks. Jesus, who has just raised Lazarus from the dead, is at the height of his popularity. People are following him everywhere and believe he is God. This has enraged the authorities who are now plotting his death. The time for Jesus "to be lifted up" is drawing near.

Jesus then reveals to his listeners, the secret of life. Not life as we know it here on earth but life everlasting with him for all eternity. "Very truly, I tell you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains just a single grain; but if it dies, it bears much fruit."

Now, go back and put yourself in the story and you ask to see Jesus. Isn't this what we all want? To see Jesus. Do we understand what it will take to see Jesus? We are the grain of wheat, and we must die to ourselves in order to produce the fruit that will bring us face to face with Jesus.

Life is continually changing, and we go through many deaths to become who we are. Sometimes the changes are voluntary, such as choosing to die to our single life to become married. Sometimes, the changes are not voluntary, and we find ourselves struggling to get over the loss of a loved one, manage an illness or deal with hurt in our relationships.

To die to self to produce the new fruit is a lifetime experience. Often, in our Christian walk of life, we understand only after time passes. Some things become clear as we mature spiritually. Others will only become clear when we see God face to face.

Perhaps you need to be free of resentment, hurt, anger, disappointment or guilt. Unless we make space for new life within us, it will never happen for us. It is in the letting go that we see Jesus. Change takes time. Planting a new seed takes time to grow. It does not bear fruit the day after you plant it. The seed may not bear fruit for years. This is the mystery of life but through it all, seen or unseen, believed or not believed, God is present.

This secret, this pattern of loss and renewal, will be unveiled everyday throughout Holy Week. I think that's why we hear this text today, a week before Palm Sunday and the start of Holy Week. It's our preparation for Holy Week. And you know where Holy Week ends, right? At Easter, the empty tomb, the dawn of a new day, and the renewal of life. The single grain has become the Bread of Life.
